## **Summary**

Safely operate motorcoaches to transport passengers at the direction of Executive Director of Convention Center.

**Essential Duties and Responsibilities** include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

Operate a motorcoach, and/or other company vehicles, as dispatched on Regularly Scheduled runs, Charter Trips, Tours, or any other trips as required. This may include, as required, waiting with Motor Coach for your passengers to return from their scheduled activities.

Safely, efficiently, and courteously drive all company vehicles on all public highways and required private property in all weather conditions; knowledge of defensive driving techniques.

Treat all passengers, company personnel, and others associated with your assigned work in a courteous and professional manner.

Cleans truck and performs basic maintenance.

Inspects truck equipment and supplies such as tires, lights, brakes, gas, oil, and water.

This job has no supervisory responsibilities.

## Qualifications

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactory. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. ## **Education and/or Experience**

High school diploma or general education degree (G.E.D.) preferred. Must have at least two years of related experience and/or training.

#### Language Skills

Basic English language skills are required. Ability to speak foreign languages helpful.

#### **Mathematical Skills**

Basic mathematical skills are required.

## **Reasoning Ability**

Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out detailed but uninvolved written or oral instructions. Ability to deal with problems involving a few concrete variables in standardized situations.

## **Computer Skills**

# Certificates, Licenses, Registrations

Must have and maintain a valid Mississippi Driver's License with at least a CDL Class C endorsement.

#### Other Skill and Abilities

Must have a driving record that is free of all major traffic citations and that is free of major "at fault" accidents Must have some prior experience with operating a tandem truck and dump truck.

#### Other Qualifications

Overtime, flexible work schedule, and on-call status may be assigned, as needed, with little or no advanced notice.

# **Physical Demands**
