Transfer fee for Perpetual Easements

The transfer of Perpetual Easements is only allowed through last will and testament or interstate succession. Transfer through the City Clerk's Office is required. (Proof of heirship may be required)

Transfer Fee for Perpetual Easements is \$75

Re-Sale to the City

Re-Sale of Perpetual Easements for interment is only allowed to re-sold to the City. The cost paid to the owner by the City is the original purchase price paid less the transfer fee. The City reserves the right to refuse to purchase.
