Job Summary

The City of Vicksburg (COV) is the recipient of a two (2) year grant awarded by the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) entitled "COVID-19 Health literacy, Accessibility, Management, Prevention, Intervention, Outcomes, and New Skills (CHAMPION) for Equitable Communities". The Health Literacy Community Outreach/Training Coordinator will facilitate and coordinate community outreach activities, partner events, and evaluation; recruit and train community health workers and program volunteers. The Community Outreach/Training Coordinator is responsible for the management of all phases of community outreach efforts including, planning, writing, testing, and implementing health literacy interventions.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

To perform this job successfully, the individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill(s), and/or ability(ies) required.

Essential Duties

- Responsible for the oversight of outreach and health activities outlined in the Project proposal. Implement high quality, customized health literacy training for residents of the City of Vicksburg and surrounding Warren County communities regarding COVID-19 causes, treatments and vaccine administration.
- Develop and implement programmatic activities related to the Health and Human Service Strategic Plan Goal 2; Healthy People 2030 objectives HC/HIT-01, HC/HIT-02, HC/HIT-03, IID-D02; COVID-19; and health disparities.
- Assist in initiating the development and execution of data-informed strategies to address the needs of groups at risk for limited health literacy regarding COVID-19.
- Work with community partners to increase access to culturally and linguistically appropriate health information for targeted populations.
- Develop and maintain a comprehensive program designed to expedite training on all aspects of health literacy, health equity, and health care for outreach and community health staff.
- Provide content regarding COVID-19 for the City of Vicksburg website and social media platforms.

- Supervise community health workers and volunteers.
- Identify and maintain relationships with outside organizations and individuals with the potential to impact Project's success.
- Prepare reports on grant activities related to outreach activities that must be reported to the U. S. Department of Health and Human Services and comply with reporting requirements.
- Increase awareness among professionals and the public on health literacy through the preparation and delivery of presentations/trainings to groups and conferences.
- Maintain a master calendar of outreach events and work closely with community partners to plan and execute all events.
- Facilitate the training of staff and sub-award recipients for evaluating learners' understanding of information provided relative to COVID-19 and health disparities in the execution of specific grant related activities.
- Other duties as assigned by the Project Director.

A Bachelor's Degree; Ability to multi-task and focus on priorities at hand; Excellent verbal, written, and training and presentation skills. Sound organizational skills, strong attention to detail, and problem-solving abilities. Excellent relationship skills and prior experience in grants management and working closely in and with diverse communities.
