Summary

Assists in the overall maintenance and operation of the Traffic Department by performing the following duties.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

Assists in the laying out and installation of Hot tape and/or painting of center lines, crosswalks, parking bays, parking lots and traffic markings.

Assists in the operation and maintenance of the paint gun and the paint machine. Utilizes a post hole digger, concrete cutter and chain saw.

Assists Signal and Traffic Electrician with signals and interstate lights.

Assists in the maintenance and installation of traffic lights.

Installs and maintains City Banners.

Setup for work zones, detours, and road closures.

Installs and maintains signs.

Operates a Bucket Truck and/or Platform truck.

Qualifications

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill and/or ability required. Education and/or Experience

High School diploma or general degree (GED) preferred. Preferably have a year experience and/or training in the electric field and general maintenance, or the equivalent combination of education and experience.

Language Skills

Basic language skills are required.

Mathematical Skills

Basic mathematical skills are required. Must be able to read drawings showing the paint layouts.

Reasoning Ability

Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out instructions furnished in oral or diagram form. Ability to deal with problems involving several concrete variables in standardized situations. Must maintain good working relations with co-workers and supervisors.

Computer Skills

Computer skills are not required for this position.

Certificates, Licenses, Registrations: Must have a valid driver's license. May be required to become IMSA Certified in signs, markings, and signals.

Other Skills and Abilities

Must be able to learn to operate and maintain a paint gun and paint machine. Must develop knowledge of traffic signals and markings. Must be able to work with little to no supervision. May be required to take a basic Electrical Test.

Other Qualifications

Must be available for on-call duty (24 hours a day, 7 days a week). Must be able to work overtime if needed and be able to work 4 a.m. to noon.

Physical Demands

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand, walk, sit, reach with hands and arms, stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl, talk or hear.
