Summary

Repairs, maintains, and constructs water lines and mains.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following, but not limited to:

Must be willing to learn how to repair water mains and lines.

Ability to use different types of tools, such as picks, shovels, probs.

Repairs, maintains, and cleans tools and other equipment.

Lays water mains/pipes.

Makes 3/4" to 12" taps to the mains/pipes.

Runs service lines.

Sets new fire hydrants.

Repairs and replaces water main valves.

Runs jack hammer, boring machine, tapping machine, walk behind trencher.

Repairs water leaks.

Pumps out pits to read out of range meters.

Hand digs with shovel and sharp shooter.

Supervisory Responsibilities

This job has no supervisory responsibilities.

Qualifications

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily.
